**Innate Spellcasting.** The Leannan Sith's innate spellcasting ability is Charisma (spell save DC 19). The Leannan Sith can innately cast the following spells, requiring no material components:

At will: charm person, minor illusion

3/day each: charm monster, dimension door, suggestion

1/day: dominate person

**Magic Resistance.** The Leannan Sith has advantage on saving throws against spells and other magical effects.

## Actions

**Multiattack.** The Leannan Sith makes two attacks with its claws.

**Claws.** Melee Weapon Attack: +9 to hit, reach 5 ft., one target. Hit: 13 (2d8 + 4) slashing damage.

**Charm.** The Leannan Sith targets one humanoid it can see within 30 feet of it. If the target can see the Leannan Sith, it must succeed on a DC 19 Wisdom saving throw against this magic or be magically charmed. The charmed creature regards the Leannan Sith as a trusted friend to be heeded and protected. Although the target isn't under the Leannan Sith's control, it takes the Leannan Sith's requests or actions in the most favorable way it can, and it is a willing target for the Leannan Sith's bite attack.

**Bite.** Melee Weapon Attack: +9 to hit, reach 5 ft., one willing humanoid charmed by the Leannan Sith, or a creature the Leannan Sith is grappling. Hit: 7 (1d6 + 4) piercing damage. The target's hit point maximum is reduced by an amount equal to the damage taken, and the Leannan Sith regains hit points

equal to that amount. The reduction lasts until the target finishes a long rest. The target dies if this effect reduces its hit point maximum to 0.
