Agana are tall snake-like creatures. They have snakelike bodies, but their forms become more humanoid at the waistline. They have scaly torsos and arms with long flexible fingers. Their faces are vaguely human but have fangs and green skin. It is not known where they came from originally, but they are primarily found on the isolated world of Rokugan where they constantly war with the human inhabitants of that world. Agana do not get along with humans anywhere. Agana, especially on Rokugan, have become famous for their use of old-fashioned bows and their amazing skill with them. They tend to inhabit forested areas, and their skin acts as a natural camouflage for them. Agana is a term from an ancient language meaning 'spirit of the forest'.

Archery: Agana are naturally good archers, they receive 2D for every 1D put into their Dexterity:Bows skill, at character creation only.

Stealth: Agana are naturally stealthy and blend into natural terrain very well. They get an automatic +1D bonus to Sneak, and another +1D if in a forest terrain, for their camouflage.

Story Factors:

Isolated: Due to their being technological primitive, the Agana are rarely found outside of a few worlds, including Rokugan which is where the majority of them can now be found.
