

Kashan NW41 Rocket Launcher

Kashan developed the NW41 in an attempt to make a mobile heavy rocket launcher capable of delivering destruction down on enemy trenches in the MetaCorp conflict. They were also used to bombard enemy armour divisions and supply trains to wreak havoc.

It had 6 launching tubes, when fired the tubes were discharged in 10 seconds. It had a two wheeled carriage with elevating and traversing gears. To avoid being tipped over by the blast while firing the rockets fired in the order following: Rockets 1, 4, 5 then 2, 3, 4. In a total of 90 seconds one series of 6 rockets could be loaded and fired. It fired at a maximum range of 6900 meters.
