Resistance to Physical Pain: Zabrak gain +1D to resist all physical pain, whether from injury or torture.

Story Factors:

Carnivorous: Although Zabrak can live on a Omnivorous diet, they are by nature Carnivores, and prefer an all meat diet.

Facial Tattoos: Zabrak Culture favours full facial tattoos, which can make them look fierce and violent, leading to other species avoiding them or being naturally intimidated by them.

Horns: Zabrak have varying numbers and patterns of horns dependent on their subspecies, and take great pride in them, seldom wearing helmets which would hide them, not that most fit over the horns anyway.

Equipment: Rotary Blaster Cannon (5D damage, The Rotary Blaster Cannons high rate of fire means that its users can lay out a virtual wall of fire, this combined with the built in recoil compensation allows the user to make his first 5 shots without multiple action penalties, however the recoil compensation also absorbs some of the operators body movement making it much harder to dodge giving opponents a bonus 3D to hit them. The weapon is also heavily prone to malfunction and grinds to a halt on the first roll of a 1 on the wild die for operating the weapon.), Black Clothing, 50 Credits, Westar-35 Blaster Pistol (4D+1 damage), knives (Str+1D damage), Machete (Str+1D damage)

Description: Icarus was a male Dathomirian Zabrak. Together with his brother Scorn, Icarus worked as a thug in service of the Zabrak crime lord and former Sith Maul, during the early Imperial Era.

History

Together with a group of Mandalorians led by Rook Kast, Scorn and Icarus raided a bank tower in Janix city belonging to crime lord Nico Deemis. Icarus and his brother took out the bank guard droids before Icarus threw some knives at one of the droids before the latter guard droid set off the vault's alarm. After causing a fight in neutral territory, the brothers assisted the Mandalorian super commando in chasing Looti Vario, in the group's stolen bank transport with Icarus used his gatling blaster to open fire , and end up destroying Vario's pilot droid before destroying Vario's landspeeder. Although Vario jumped onto the bank transport and used a flamethrower, which staggered the group. After recovering Icarus used his chaingun to distract Captain Brander Lawson and Two-Boots when they arrived, saving Vario.

Later, the brothers assisted Maul in his attack on the Janix Civil Defense HQ to free the crime lord and Maul's former associate Looti Vario, but Icarus was shot in the arm by Lawson but continued to fight and later take Vario alive.

While escaping the police headquarters, the group ascend a ladder where they are pinned down by

blaster fire from Lawson and the other officers. Icarus provided cover so the group can escape. Once out, Icarus blasted the controls to cause the doors to close. Icarus boarded the smaller landspeeder with Scorn, a Mandalorian super commando, and Vario. The landspeeder was wrecked when a Mosyk individual uses the Force to flip and crash the smaller speeder, which the bank transport collides with it. As Scorn and the others climb out of the speeder, Maul faces off with the Jedi Master, as the police forces arrive. Maul uses the Force to split a nearby pedestrian walkway to distract his pursuers, forcing Daki to hold the bridge up and Lawson to save the civilians.

After heading down to a secret hideout in the lower levels of Janix city, Icarus departed as a Mandalorian tended to his injuries he sustained during the breakout and later watched as Maul drops a crate of credit bricks to force Vario to cooperate to kill Marg Krim, leader of the Pyke Syndicate.

Scorn went with Icarus and Kast to a warehouse where Two-Boots and Officer Reb were arresting four Pyke enforcers and two smugglers of Vario's syndicate, where Kast fired a rocket at a crate, injuring Reb and killing the criminals. As Two-Boots pursued the crew, both Kast and Scorn provide cover before escaping on the bank transport.

After getting back to the hideout, Icarus watches Kast has Vario send a message to the Pykes and inform Krim that rogue lieutenants of Nico Deemis' syndicate were behind the shipments attacks and will return the stolen cargo to him.

After arriving at the Pyke Palace on Oba Diah, Icarus, pretending to be Maul, exited the ship and attacked the Pykes with Maul's lightsaber before being stunned in the back by Vario. Icarus was delivered in front of Krim, who recognized him as not being Maul when he took off the hood, but it was too late and Maul entered the room and killed Krim and many of his guards before forcing Kalt, the Captain of the Guard as the new leader.

Personality and traits

Icarus had orange skin, red eyes, and light-colored horns. Similarly to Maul and Scorn, his face and body were covered with black tattoos, including the entirety of his ears. He wore black clothing with bare arms and often hid the lower half of his face behind a black cowl. He was considered hulking and imposing. Icarus was loyal soldier to Maul and found unbridled glee in using his heavy rotary blaster cannon in combat. In close combat, he was also able to expertly wield a machete; able to throw several knives at Deemis' bank guard droids and three TK stormtroopers, and also used a WESTAR-35 blaster pistol and a missile launcher. Icarus also possessed some mechanical skills, as he repaired Maul's cybernetic legs after his duel with Jedi Master Eeko-Dio Daki. Although the repairs weren't enough to aid Maul in his duel with the Inquisitors.
