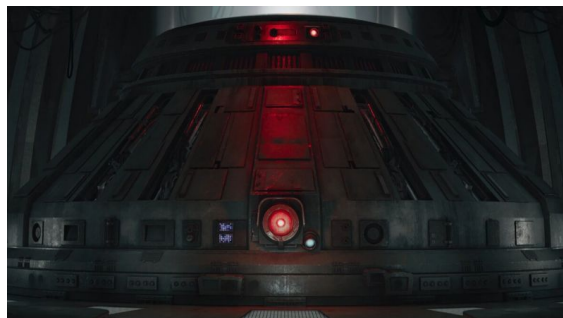

Biography
